It is hard to believe that the last week of term is here. This email has some important information, so please read carefully.

#### **Prizegivings**

This year we have a split prizegiving due to the unavailability of the school gym. The primary (Y1-8) prizegiving will take place at the Town Hall on Wednesday 13th at 1pm, doors will open from 12.40 onwards. You may take your child home at the conclusion of this event.

The senior (Y9-13) prizegiving will take place on the same day at 7pm, also in the Town Hall. Doors will open from 6.40pm. Please note that winter uniform is required.

#### **School Magazines**


